

UOP PARKING

For Stockton Folk Dance Camp 2025

Paying for parking at the University of the Pacific is new for SFDC and it is important everyone understands how the system works. The information below includes procedures to guide you through the process, links to the forms you will need to complete your parking registration, and important deadlines.

Parking is enforced by Campus Police who drive through the UOP parking lots daily. They simply aim a camera at your license plate and a computer program immediately determines if you have a permit or not. Under most circumstances, we must provide UOP with our vehicle license plate numbers, etc. *in advance*, so the information can be put into the parking system. It's so very easy to enforce parking that you will surely be ticketed if you forget to purchase a permit.

Here are the 3 choices for those attending SFDC who need parking:

ONE-WEEK SFDC DISCOUNTED PERMIT \$18 per week: For **A LIMITED TIME**, you may purchase a one-week discounted permit. This is ONLY available for those attending Stockton Folk Dance Camp. The **deadline** to purchase a one-week pass is **May 31st**. After this deadline, you **MUST** use one of the other parking permit options. Keep in mind that if you are attending both weeks of SFDC, you will need **TWO** one week permits.

To purchase a discounted SFDC parking permit using a *credit card*, fill out the online form at this link: [Pay online with credit card](#)

To pay using a *check*, go to the link below, fill out the form and mail it, along with a check, to the address listed on the form. [Pay for Permit by check](#) The information **MUST** arrive by May 31st.

UOP ONE MONTH PERMIT B: This permit is administered by UOP through this link: <https://pacific.cmrpay.com/permits/dashboard>. It currently costs \$50 for 31 days. You may select the start date. These permits are only sold 6 weeks in advance, so you will need to wait until mid-June to purchase it. Step by step instructions are on our website Parking Page. The basic instructions:

Sign up for a UOP account. Use the Dashboard page to purchase the permit. Choose **Permit B Monthly Stockton** from the dropdown menu. You will enter your information, including the license plate details for your car. Pay for the permit by credit card. Right now, the cost is \$50, but we can't guarantee that it won't go up, so purchase as soon as it's available in mid-June.

DAILY RATE: If you do not purchase either a weekly discounted permit or a one-month permit, you will need to download the PassportParking.com app onto your phone, and then set up an account, including your license plate and credit card information for payment. Then you must use the app to pay for parking, **EVERYDAY, BEFORE 8:00 AM**, each and every weekday that you park on the campus. **DO NOT FORGET TO DO THIS EACH DAY** or you will receive a parking ticket. From 8 am - 5 pm on Monday through Friday, the rate is \$8 a day. If you will only be parking on campus for a short time, the hourly rate is \$2/hour. Weekends are free. Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

What if I have a Handicap Placard or Plate?

A parking permit is still required to park on the UOP campus, but you may use the handicap parking spaces in the B Permit areas. Be sure to display your properly issued parking placard or license plate while parked in a handicap space. Again, be sure to park in a B Permit area of a lot.

What if I don't know the license number because I will have a rental car or I buy a new-to-me car after the deadline?

If you want to purchase the SFDC discounted weekly pass, fill out as much of the Parking Application form as possible and explain the situation in the "comments" section. Then, **MAKE VERY SURE YOU GIVE SFDC THE RENTAL CAR or NEW CAR LICENSE PLATE INFORMATION to an Office Person AS SOON AS YOU ARRIVE (or before, if at all possible)**. This is YOUR responsibility. UOP is making a special concession to SFDC in offering the reduced-rate weekly permits. We must provide them with this information as much in advance as possible. If you forget, it is likely you will receive a parking ticket.

Can I put more than one license on my monthly or weekly permit?

A permit is good for one car in the lot at a time. If you are not sure which car you will drive, register both under the same permit. But do **NOT** have both cars on campus at the same time. Both cars will be ticketed! If you are bringing two vehicles or a trailer and will park them on campus at the same time, **BOTH** vehicles will need a monthly or weekly permit or a daily permit.

What if I entered the wrong license number?

You may edit your ONE month permit before the start date, to reflect the corrected license number on your Dashboard.

If you purchased the Discounted Weekly Permit, **please INFORM THE SFDC PARKING CHAIR (Bill East) AS SOON AS POSSIBLE**. It *may* be possible to correct the information through UOP.

What if I get a Ticket?

The instructions for paying the ticket are on the back of the paper ticket. If you feel that you received the ticket in error, see the "Citation Appeal Policies and Procedures" on the ticket. You may need to go to the Campus Police Office and speak with the Captain.
